#### **SECTION 1: RISK ASSESSMENT SUMMARY**

#### COVID-19 RISK ASSESSMENT OF OPERATIONAL SITES (PHASE 1)

A COVID-19 Risk Assessment of operational sites has been undertaken to identify all controls in place within WCM Europe to manage the risks, wellbeing and operational requirements of the business following the impacts of COVID-19. The control measures specified to reduce risk are based on current guidance from the UK and devolved Governments (England and Wales), Society of Motor Manufacturers and Traders, as well as existing operational standards within WCM Europe.

This Risk Assessment has been carried out by the Senior Management Team within WCM Europe within the period of May/June 2020 as part of an ongoing exercise to evaluate the controls in place. This Risk Management Document will continue to be reviewed and updated as and when required to reflect any additional controls that are deemed to be necessary.

WCM Europe considers its employee's health, safety and wellbeing to be of the upmost importance when in the workplace, therefore all necessary steps required to implement against this Risk Assessment are being introduced where possible. This Risk Assessment will be used in conjunction with existing WCM Health and Safety Policies to guide decision making.

This Risk Assessment has been fully reviewed in September 2020 to reflect the ongoing changes in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. WCM will at all times adhere to the current UK Government legislation.

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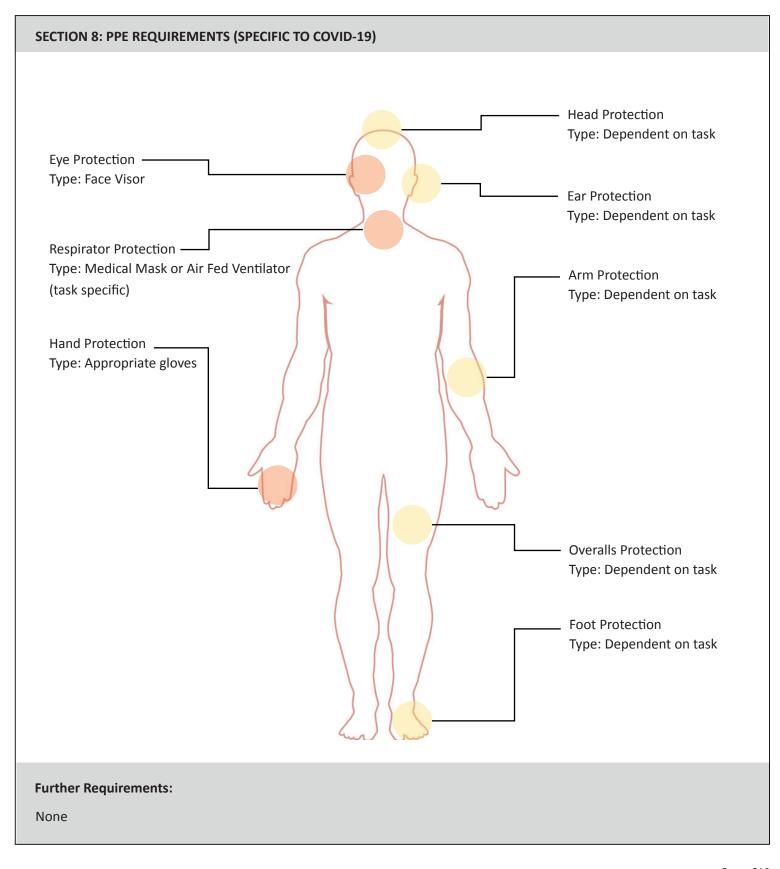












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
